



- Takes care of his belongings







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## Primary 2 English Language Curriculum

### Strategies for English Language Learning and Reading (STELLAR)

#### **STELLAR's Vision**

To develop pupils' language skills and love for reading through the use of rich texts including children's literature as well as a range of multi -modal resources.




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### STELLAR 2.0 and ELS 2020

- Sharper focus on 21st century competencies
- More explicit teaching and learning of skills
- Stronger curricular alignment and revision





## P2 English Language Curriculum

- Continuation of the Stellar 2.0 curriculum
- Reading, Speaking, Listening, Writing
- Answering questions in complete sentences and with elaboration
- Start writing in short paragraphs





- Encourage your child to speak about his daily experiences
- Remind him to speak in complete sentences
- Allow him to share and suggest words to replace the usual words (e.g. wonderful instead of nice, amazing instead of good etc)
- Build his confidence to communicate fluently and coherently



## Writing

- Encourage your child to write, in a sketch book or on slips of paper.
- Do not be upset when he cannot spell it right.
- Do not use a red pen to mark it, it can be discouraging for him.
- Help him build up courage to pen his thoughts

### Pictorial


Representation of skills / ideas as a diagram or picture

#### Learning Support for Mathematics

The LSM programme provides early support to help selected students develop essential mathematical concepts, skills, and dispositions for effective learning.



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## Supporting your child in Mathematics s

#### Encourage

- To put in effort and complete his work on time
- To write neatly
- Ask if in doubt

#### <u>Review</u>

- Revisit concepts and skills regularly
- Help to develop factual fluency
- Explore Mathematics in real -world (Eg: buying of groceries, plan for dinner, baking)

#### Partnership

- Use common Mathematics language
- Monitor progress and communicate with Mathematics teachers


- Use of NTUC to indicate types of errors
  - NT: Number Transfer Error
  - U: Missing/ wrong units
  - C: Calculation error
- Use of Annotations to encourage critical thinking and better understanding





### Edusave Merit Bursary (P1/P2) and Good Progress Award (P2/P3)

- These awards celebrate the child's learning milestones and encourage progress and effort
- Deserving students are selected using a class based selection and must demonstrate good conduct in school
- Selection is done through observation of learning behaviour throughout the year (e.g. during lessons, class assignments, group projects and homework)

- Homework contributes towards building responsibility, self-discipline and lifelong learning habits
- It is our intention to assign relevant, challenging and meaningful homework assignments that reinforce classroom learning objectives.
- Homework assigned would provide students with the opportunity to apply information they have learned, develop skills they were taught, complete unfinished class assignments, and develop independence.



## Progression from P2 to P3

- 1. Consideration of age appropriateness for streaming
  - a) Reduce the fine differentiation from P2 to P3
  - b) Every Class will have students who have different strengths in learning
- 2. Cater to the differing abilities of the children
  - a) High Progress After School Thoburn Programme at P4
  - b) Low Progress Pull-Out / Remediation Programme
- 3. Enbloc movement of students from P3 to P4
  - a) Deepen relationships among students and between teachers and students
  - b) Constant FTs provide stability and follow -up learning routines
