
Mark types	How they are awarded
Method Mark (M Mark)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awarded for applying the correct mathematical approach or strategy. • Awarded for alternative methods that are mathematically correct. • Not awarded if the method is mathematically incorrect, even if it produces the correct answer.
Answer Mark (A Mark)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awarded for a numerically correct answer. • Not awarded for 'correct' answers obtained from incorrect methods or when no working/methods are shown.

Presentation of Work

Students **must** present their mathematical work clearly and systematically. Please refer to the examples below for guidance on proper work presentation.

Example

Siti had \$1200. She bought a laptop and had \$450 left. How much did the laptop cost?



Left \rightarrow $\$1200 - \$450 = \$750$

← Writing equation(s)

She had \$750 left.

← Write the final answer. Students are also encouraged to write a final statement. Marks will be awarded based on whichever is more accurate (the final answer or the final statement).

→ Ans: \$750
